The Property

Tucked behind a leafy front garden with mature planting and offroad parking, Crown Cottage is a truly enchanting one-bedroom period home, full of personality and character. Spread across two floors, the cottage balances cosy charm with thoughtful layout and light-filled spaces.

A stable door opens into the entrance porch, leading to a warm and inviting sitting room where a beautiful inglenook fireplace with exposed brickwork and a wood-burning stove takes centre stage. The kitchen is bathed in natural light thanks to twin Velux windows and offers a smart, cottage-style layout with tiled flooring, along with a pantry/utility cupboard cleverly tucked to the side.

A winding staircase leads to the upper floor, where you'll find a well-proportioned double bedroom, a dressing room, and a modern shower room. Outside, the enclosed courtyard-style garden offers peace and privacy, with established borders and a delightful brick-built shed that could be used for storage, a workshop, or even a small studio.

This rare little gem would make an ideal full-time residence, peaceful pied-à-terre, or charming holiday let, just minutes from the Suffolk Heritage Coast.

Location - Knodishall

Knodishall is a traditional Suffolk village just a few miles from the coast at Aldeburgh and within easy reach of Snape Maltings, Thorpeness, and RSPB Minsmere. The village itself retains a friendly and relaxed character, with a village green, community shop, post office, and the well-regarded Butcher's Arms pub just a short walk from the cottage.

Knodishall's location makes it highly desirable for those seeking a quieter pace of life while remaining well connected. With nearby access to the A12 and mainline rail links at Saxmundham and Darsham, it's an ideal setting for a weekend retreat or year-round home.
